4th and 5th grades: After school drama proposal; The goal of this program is to provide our students with an after-school performing arts offering that could supplement their in-school VAPA classes. This program would be open to all students in grades 4 and 5. Classes would take place twice a week from 3:15pm - 4:00pm (immediately following dismissal). My preference would be Mondays and Wednesdays, but I'm open to other configurations as needed by the school. The 4th/5th grade drama course would run for 12 sessions from 2/23/26 - 4/3/26 so as not to conflict with Enrichment Club. If desired, the final class for this program could be an open class that parents could come and watch. The cost of this program would be the same district stipend as the Opera Together program. My understanding, unless something has changed, is that this is co-curricular stipend A-1 (\$1,291.58). The curriculum for this class would be drawn from the curriculum I was trained to teach while working with New Conservatory Theatre Center in San Francisco. It would consist of improv games that are designed to teach confidence, storytelling, and creativity.
