Good to encourage kids to read; excited for another book fair Raul is excited and wants to help more/do more for the school; need to think through what he can do, such a great leader
	 Kindergarten Tours Have had 2 successful tours; 3rd and final March 15th at 3:15; at first our incoming Kinder registration was low, but more have come in since tours; 13 total so far, often get more further into the year
	 2022 – 2023 scheduling options – Amy asked for parent's input When we re-opened last spring, redesigned for hybrid, and in fall, had to change the bell schedule Have been working with trying to streamline bell schedule with the other elementary schools for next year Would like parent input to ensure it works well for students, families, teachers, etc. Amy: What input do we have to share: Kelly: Cunha and FV have same exact start times/schedules; consider other school times Staggered drop off times; hoping we can have common start time Different start time on Tuesdays for older grades has been tough Danielle/Kelly/Kristi: Weekly Minimum Days are tough on families; we understand and appreciate the need for teacher prep time; if weekly minimum days are kept, would be nice to move them to Fridays Traffic should be considered too, so start time
