



Amy: Received about 18 emails on the topic and notified teachers of the topics. Two teachers responded - 1 was comfortable with parents on campus if masked, but not comfortable with unvaccinated volunteers; Another teacher who responded stated they spoke with handful of teachers who were not comfortable with parents on campus or unvaccinated parent volunteers.

We will be changing these protocols at some point; they weren't meant to last forever. They were meant to support the 4 pillars and keep everyone as safe and healthy as possible.

Amy is continuously discussing with district leaders and consulting with legal counsel; our superintendent is consulting with other superintendents as well.
